



b. I, the undersigned ..... the governmental veterinarian in – charge acknowledge that the live animals of the above descriptions satisfy the following conditions:

- The hatching eggs from a country in which the highly pathogenic avian flu was not recorded in domesticated birds and in captive birds for at least 12 months prior to export in accordance the published animal health reports, or have freedom for a minimum period of 28 days after the successful control applying a stamping-out policy and disinfection after an outbreak in country which has been previously free , and provided that surveillance is applied in accordance with World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH) code.
- The eggs from zones\* which are free from Newcastle for at least 3 months if case of applying a stamping-out policy or 12 months if the stamping-out policy is not applied ( Delete if not applicable)
- The eggs from establishment free from other notifiable bird diseases for at least 3 months or tests to ensure that they are free of these diseases that have been recorded in the 3 months prior to shipment.
- Eggs from farms are subject to regular supervision and inspection by the competent veterinary authority.
- In case of parents were vaccinated, the types and dates of vaccinations should be mentioned within 3 months prior to exportation
